This month...

Summer days and Summer nights:

→ During the day refresh yourself, jump onto the slides and enjoy a world of water at the different aquatic parks located near Barcelona: Illa Fantasia, Caribe Aquatic Park or Marineland.

→ And when the sun comes down...there is a wide range of night activities for you: **walking tours, panoramic bus tours, concerts at unique spaces** and much more.



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COOL DOWN WITHOUT SAND

Apart from its beaches, you can also cool down in one of Barcelona's many swimming pools: the open sea saltwater pool at the Fòrum area, a new urban beach concept, the artificial lake at Can Dragó, the largest outdoor swimming pool in Nou Barris, or the similarly large public pool in Parc de la Creueta del Coll, a green area in Gràcia. In the Eixample, head to Torre de les Aigües (Roger de Llúria, 56), a garden with swimming pool in a recovered green area, the Picornell swimming pools, in the Olympic area of Montjuïc, which also has an outdoor pool, like most municipal facilities. And outside the city, Costa Caribe Aquatic Park (pictured below) is the water park of PortAventura World, 50,000 m² for you to cool down and have fun.

del Rellotge, an old lighthouse that has been converted into a clock tower, and the **Cofradía de Pescadores**. It is worth visiting this fishermen's association to learn about its history, see how the fishermen arrive to the port, visit the fish market and enjoy a seafood meal.

And hop on board a **sailing boat**, **catamaran** or **Karya**, an authentic Turkish schooner that sails from **Moll d'Espanya**, if you want to contemplate the coastline from the sea. But if you prefer to feel like a true Barcelonan from the 19th century, board one of the traditional "**golondrinas**" (swallows) sailing from **Portal de la Pau**. You can enjoy another historical cruise on the **Cruero** sailboat, which includes entrance to the **Museu Marítim** at Drassanes Reials (former royal shipyards), the perfect place to discover the city's maritime



Summer in Barcelona

Barcelona is synonymous with the Mediterranean and a long tradition that dates back to Roman times. The sea has been and still is an essential part of Barcelona. It is a meeting place for cultures, playful and open to all, with a wide range of resources, infrastructures and activities for all ages and audiences.

If you like sailing, water sports or simply relaxing by the sea, in Barcelona you can enjoy your favourite activities while admiring its coastline and beaches.

From **Sant Sebastià** in the south, one of the city's oldest and most popular beaches, to **Parc del Fòrum** in the north, an artificial saltwater pool area, you will find ten beaches that have been adapted for people with reduced mobility and can be easily reached by public transport.

Kayaking, diving, paddle surfing, jet skiing and fly fishing are just some of the water activities you can do, most of them based at **Port Olímpic**, an area presided by two familiar skyscrapers of the Barcelona skyline.

Following the coastline, you will come across **Barceloneta**, the city's traditional fishing quarter, with its beach of **Sant Sebastià**, **Passeig Marítim** and **Port Vell**, which houses the **Torre**

history. You can also choose to take a sailboat at Port Vell that includes a vermouth or breakfast on board.

In front of Port Vell stands the Mirador de Colón, at the end of the Rambla, providing you with panoramic views of the city at a height of 60 metres. Stretching out below you is the Rambla del Mar, a wooden walkway that leads to the Maremagnum shopping and entertainment centre.

Barcelona coast

Beaches of fine golden sand and shallow waters extend not only for 5 km along the Barcelona coastline, but also for 95 km along the coast of other towns in the Barcelona province.

Highlights close to the city include the beaches of Montgat (Maresme), ideal for lovers of surfing, windsurfing and kitesurfing, the 5 km of sand of Castelldefels (Baix Llobregat) and

Sitges (El Garraf), with a variety of beach options (sand, coves, nudist...) and a charming Modernista legacy.

Summer with the family

The same coastline offers you a variety of other activities to enjoy with the family. See and even swim with sharks at L'Aquarium, visit Museu Blau, the city's natural science museum at Parc del Fòrum, an area that is also home to Barcelona Bosc Urbà, an adventure space with more than 50 attractions, including bungee jumping, zip lines... and on platforms of up to 60 metres in height.

Other places offering family activities include CosmoCaixa, with its science workshops, and CaixaForum, with its film season for children, "Petits Cinèfils". El Poble Espanyol organises workshops with its artisans and rock concerts to introduce youngsters to live music, while the Museu de la Xocolata stages the sweet-

test experiences of all. If you love sport, the Camp Nou Experience is the perfect place to go for Barçafans, and you will feel like a sports star for a day at Open Camp. Two classic attractions are the Zoo, in Parc dela Ciutadella, and Tibidabo, with its attractions and magnificent views. And one hour away from Barcelona, PortAventura World guarantees you fun in its three theme parks: PortAventura, Costa Caribe Aquatic Park and the new Ferrari Land.

Summer nights

Summer nights in the city include a wide range of entertainment and culture activities in unique spaces. There is live blues at Poble Espanyol every Thursday, the best short films of the last Barcelona International Short and Animation Film Festival at Mecal Air every Friday, and musical cinema with karaoke and live entertainment at Sing-Along.

While the Music in the Parks programme is staging 50 free concerts of classical music, jazz and blues in about thirty green spaces in the city until August 31.

Casa Amatller is offering film and stage shows during summer nights, including a dramatized tour and glass of cava, and Pa-

lau Robert is screening a film or a series in original version on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays in its outdoor tent. Until August 24, the Museu del Disseny is running its David Bowie exhibition and screening *Bowie Cinema*, a series of films and documentaries about the singer. Sala Montjuïc is screening films in a castle moat until August 4, preceded by a short film and live music and with deck-chairs for hire.

CCCB is offering *Gandules* ("deck-chairs" in Catalan), a season of outdoor cinema that this year is paying tribute to women, with nine films featuring ground-breaking characters. The season runs from August 8 to 24, on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays at 10pm at the Pati de les Dones (free).

Yet more evening options: Spanish guitar with a drink at the church of Santa Anna or the basilica of Santa Maria del Pi, which also stages Spanish guitar concerts, or a medieval dinner show at Palau Requesens. You can also dine while observing the heavens and views of the city at the Observatori Fabra, enjoy a drink while watching opera and flamenco at the Gothic Palau Dalmases, or see the spectacular Magic Fountain show on Montjuïc.

And one final suggestion to discover the city at night is to hop on the Barcelona Night Tour Bus, which gives you a two-and-a-half-hour journey through the city's most important entertainment and cultural areas. ◇

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

Passport to the best museums

BARCELONA IS ART, CREATIVITY AND HISTORY. AND ALL THIS IS AT YOUR FINGERTIPS WITH ARTICKET, A COMBINATION TICKET PROVIDING ENTRY TO SIX MAJOR MUSEUMS



Discover the work of such 20th-century art geniuses as Picasso, Miró and Tàpies while journeying across a thousand years of creativity. All of Barcelona's art is at your fingertips with the combination **Articket**, which represents a significant saving over the sum of individual tickets. Modern art, Renaissance, Gothic, Romanesque... at six venues offering permanent and temporary exhibitions in spaces that are as emblematic as the valuable works they contain.

The **Museu Picasso** (Montcada, 15-23), in the neighbourhood of La Ribera, just a stone's throw from the Born, deserves a visit purely for its architecture alone.

It is housed in five Gothic palaces dating from the 13th and 14th centuries. The permanent collection includes works by Picasso focusing on his formative years in Barcelona, including *Motherhood* (1903).

The **Fundació Miró** is housed in

an outstanding modern building designed by Josep Lluís Sert, located on the hill of Montjuïc. It contains the best and most comprehensive collection of paintings, sculptures and graphic works by this Catalan artist, one of the most influential of the last century, and it also has a restaurant with terrace, garden and Mediterranean menu.

The **Fundació Antoni Tàpies** (Aragó, 255) is housed in a Modernista building designed by Puig i Cadafalch located in the Eixample district, now converted into an art centre and crowned by a striking Tàpies sculpture: *Cloud and Chair*.

Another museum you simply must visit is the **Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya**, home to a thousand years of art, from Romanesque to Modernisme, located in the Palau Nacional on Montjuïc. The palace itself deserves a visit, as you can enjoy splendid panoramic views of the city from its terraces or enjoy dishes by the (two Michelin star) chef of its Òleum restaurant, located in the building's former throne room.

The **Museu d'Art Contemporani de Barcelona (MACBA)** can be found in Plaça dels Àngels in Ciutat Vella, Barcelona's old town. Designed by Richard Meier, it focuses on modern art creations of the past 50 years. Visit its *Forensic Architecture* exhibition until October 15. The Centre de Cultura Contemporània de Barcelona (CCCB) is located nearby at Montalegre, 5, a multidisciplinary space for the creativity, outreach, display and discussion of any expression of contemporary art. It is currently running the *Photobook Phenomenon* exhibition until August 27. ◇

TWO UNIQUE MUSEUMS

GAUDÍ EXHIBITION CENTER



The **Gaudí Exhibition Center** is the best place to begin to learn about the architect, a place to understand his work and his revolutionary methods in an enjoyable manner. And you will do so in a medieval building beside the cathedral that houses the Museu Diocesà, including an audio guide in ten languages, a 180-degree video and a set of virtual reality glasses. You will also discover some truly original objects and documents. Delve into Gaudí's mind and stroll with him in a surprising setting with this interactive show. ◇ gaudieexhibitioncenter.com

MEAM, MORE THAN A MUSEUM

The **Museu Europeu d'Art Modern (MEAM)** is housed in Palau Gomis, an 18th-century palace in the Born. Visit to see its collection, which encompasses modern figurative painting and sculpture, while enjoying the musical performances it stages. Thursdays is dedicated to flamenco and a drink, while Fridays has live blues and Saturdays there is live classical music and a snack. ◇ meam.es

WINE TOURISM WITH VIEWS

Taste some wines and cavas from four wine regions in Catalonia – Alella, Catalunya, Penedès and Pla de Bages – while enjoying the excellent panoramic views of the city from the vantage point at the wine tourism space housed in the **Mirador de Colón** (Pl. Portal de la Pau), and also purchase some bottles of the ones you like most. Then take the opportunity to sign up for one of the wine tourism experiences that it offers in Barcelona or nearby. ♦

taste the best tapas on the **Barcelona Tapas Tour** while discovering the city with an experienced guide recounting stories and anecdotes about the places you visit. And the **Bus Turístic Catalonia Wine and Cava Tour** visits three wineries in the Penedès region, including visits to their cellars, tastings and pairings.

Courses and workshops

If tasting these delights is not enough for you, then join a workshop and learn how to make local specialities. The **Gastronomic Workshop** at the Boqueria market will teach you how to prepare gazpacho, tortilla with pa amb tomàquet, paella and crema catalana. While the **Cocktail Workshop** will teach you how to make mojitos, caipirinhas, gin and tonics... at the Agüeloo 13 restaurant and cocktail bar, located next to the Roman wall. And the **Cooking Workshop** at the 4 Capellans restaurant in Hotel Barcelona Catedral includes a dinner with tips and tricks from its chef.

Culture and gastronomy

The **Òpera Samfaina** is a surprising gastronomic experience to discover gourmet Catalonia that you can enjoy without leaving Barcelona. It takes place in the building housing the Gran Teatre del Liceu and includes a guided tour and tasting menu washed down by a selection of local wi-

nes. And **Visit Penedès** in the Penedès region offer tastings, vineyard tours, workshops... to enjoy an experience in one of the major wine and cava regions of Catalonia.

Tastings and pairings

Barcelona's Wine Tasting activity allows you to taste four local wines served by a sommelier and reveals some wine tasting secrets. While **Bodegas Torres**, in the heart of the Penedès, will show you how to distinguish a good wine or cava and which food pairs best with them with a pairing of three local stars: wine, cheese and ham. ♦

Centuries of history on the shores of the Mediterranean, a privileged climate, the passage of various civilisations, its fresh produce, fishing, crops... all these elements have left a strong legacy on the wine and culinary traditions of Barcelona and the rest of Catalonia. The city and its surrounding area offer a variety of experiences to enjoy this wine and food heritage, including tastings, walks, routes, tours, pairings...

Visits and guided tours

This legacy has filled the city and its surrounding area with specialised

establishments featuring local produce. Joining a tour is a good way to discover first-hand this wealth of wine and gastronomy. The **Barcelona Walking Tour Gourmet** is a guided tour of emblematic establishments in the city to discover the gourmet you carry inside. And if you have a sweet tooth, then sign up for the **Barcelona Sweet Tour** and discover the chocolate shops, cafés and pastry shops of the Barri Gòtic and Born neighbourhoods.

The **Market Lover Tour** offers a guided tour of the Ninot market, in Barcelona's Eixample district, including some tapas and meal. You will also

The traditional festivals of Barcelona's most iconic neighbourhoods, classy concerts, the Joan Gamper Trophy, Circuit activities... Far from

everything stopping in August, Barcelona's cultural and festive life is very much alive, with activities for all tastes.

TRADITIONS

The end of summer is the time for traditional festivals in the towns and cities of Catalonia, kicking off in Barcelona with the **Festa Major de Gràcia** (Aug. 15-21). The neighbourhood is this year celebrating the 200th anniversary of its great festival week, with more than

400 activities to enjoy local traditions: decorated streets, castells (human towers), correfocs (fire runs), live music in squares such as Sol and Diamant... While the envelat (big top) set up in Jardines de Gràcia will host exhibitions, children's activities, crafts, food talks, swing and zumba classes...

The Sants neighbourhood

Music

The **Mas i Mas Festival** offers a world-class eclectic musical programme, a classic event taking place on evenings in August. Various venues in the city (Teatre Grec, Palau de la Música, Born Centre de Cultura i Memòria, Jambo-ree...) are hosting concerts from July 28 to September 3.

The programme kicks off on August 4 with a flamenco jazz concert by pianist **Chano Domínguez** and singer **Mariola Membrives** at **Teatre Grec**, a new venue for this year's edition, followed by some flamenco by **Eva Yerbabuena** and her latest release, **Apariencias**, August 10. The **Proyecto Piazzola** tango show from Buenos Aires can be seen on August 22.

The voice of **Mario Biondi** will resound in the **Palau de la Música** on August 2 and a four-handed piano concert will be held on August 11, with Girona pianists **Carles Llama** and

Sofia Cabruja, and another duo of pianists, **Ignasi Terraza and Bert van den Brink**, performing on August 25 in a tribute concert to the great jazz artist **Tete Montoliu: 20 years without Tete**.

Another venue, the **Born Centre de Cultura i Memòria**, is hosting the jazz of **Celeste Aliás** on August 5, while the tango of **Quinteto Real** takes the stage on August 26. Barcelona's temple to jazz, **Jamboree**, will host Boston's Queen of the Blues, **Toni Lynn Washington**, on August 1 and 2, accompanied by Sax Gordon & the **Luca Giordano Band**, while August 3 sees more blues with the guitarist **King Solomon**. Crooner **Agustí Burriel** will perform Frank Sinatra songs on August 13 and the **Michele Hendricks Quintet**, led by a jazz legend, will play on August 25 and 26.

The **Mas i Mas** techno sets will take place at **Sala Mog** with **Massa** on August 8, **Aitor Ronda** on August 13, **DJ Men** on August 20 and **Gus van Sound**, one of Barcelona's most important DJs, on August 26.

also celebrates its traditional festival between August 20 and 28, another perfect occasion to feel the pulse of the city, including such standbys as a traditional fireworks show to end this year's celebration.

One of the most spectacular of these traditional festivals in Catalonia will be held close to Barcelona, in **Vilafranca del Penedès**, from August 29 to September 2, culminating on August 30 with **Saint Fèlix Day**, the patron saint of this town. A unique occasion to enjoy a mix of local folklore, shows and music.

Flamenco will take centre stage at **Sala Tarantos** with the dancers of **Karime Amaya** from August 7 to 13 and **Conchi Maya** and **Iñaki Márquez** from August 14 to 20. The **Tablao Cordobes**, in the city centre, will host dance performers such as **Jesús Carmona** (Aug. 1-31) and **Sara Barrero** (Aug. 1-15), while you can enjoy a dinner and flamenco show at **Poble Espanyol**.

Outside of the Festival programme, Britain's **PJ Harvey** will perform her best-known songs at **Poble Espanyol** on August 23. And there is **Brunch in the Park** every Sunday at **Jardins Joan Brossa**, on the hill of Montjuïc, a family friendly event with electronic music for all, food trucks and attractions.

Multiculturalism

The 10th edition of the **Circuit Festival**, an LGTBlevent that has outdone itself with this year's 10th anniversary programming, has 15 days of activities and theme parties from August 5 to 20, including culture, sport... and more than 50 artists at several venues: **Sutton Club**, **Razzmatazz**, **Fantasy Island**, **Mar Bella beach...**

The football season kicks off with the **Joan Gamper Trophy** (Aug. 7), organised by **FC Barcelona**, with the host team this year playing Brazil's Chapecoense. Also at Camp Nou, **Barça and Real Madrid** will face off in the first leg of the **Spanish Super Cup** and the first round of the Spanish **Liga** will commence in August. The dates of these two matches have yet to be confirmed. ◇

All of them offer a great variety of fashion, personal care products, services, cafés and restaurants... as well as entertainment options (La Maquinista and Las Arenas both contain multiplexes). In addition, some also have supermarkets and fresh produce markets, selling top quality local products.



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
