

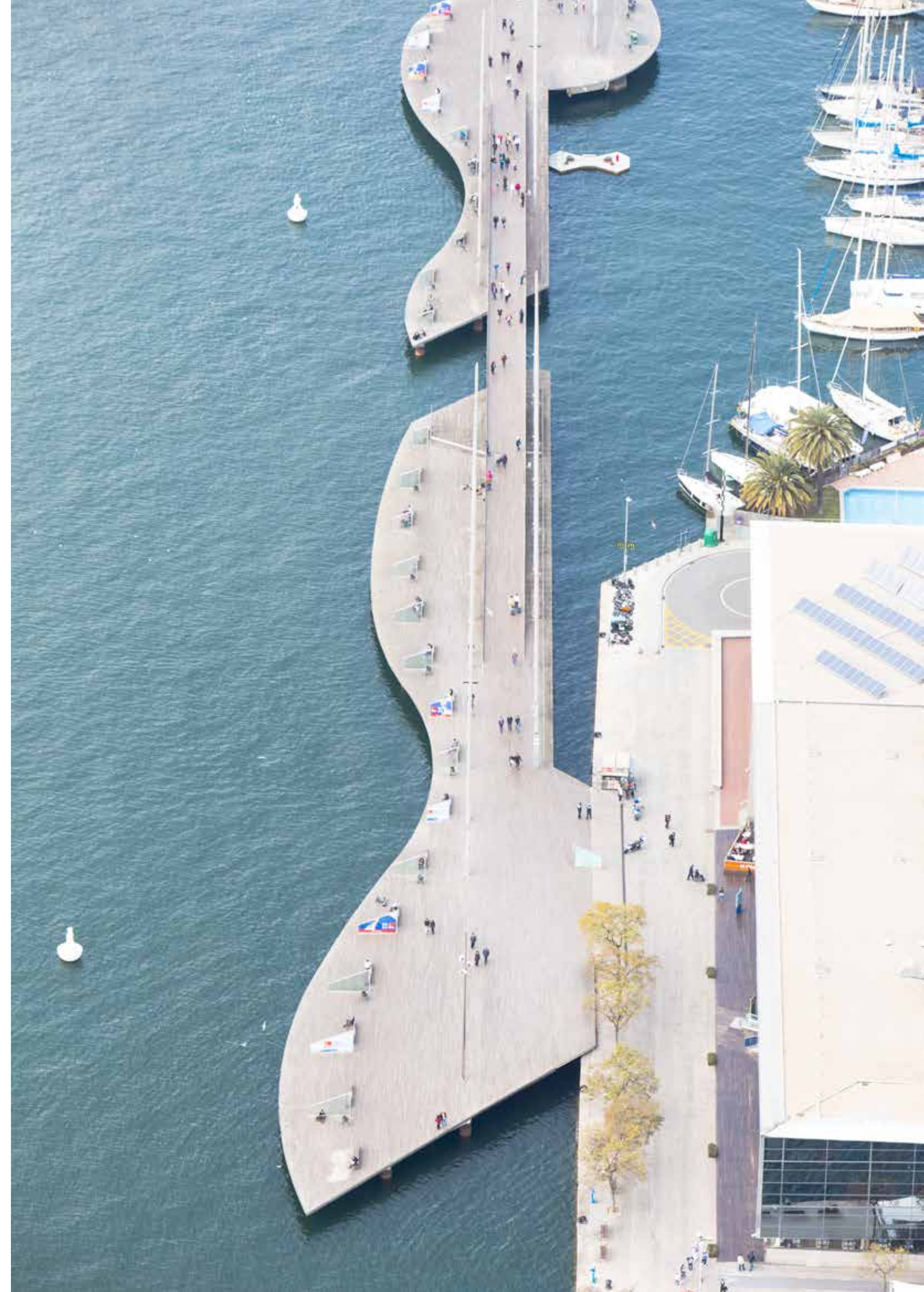


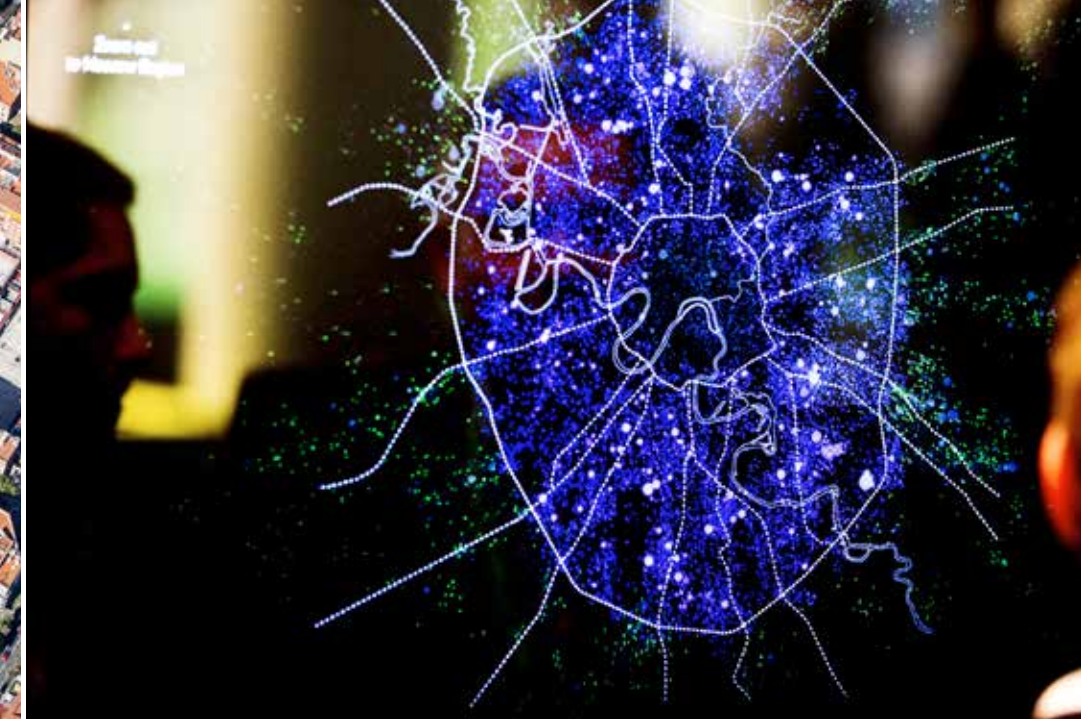

Fira Barcelona - Gran Via

Gran Via Fira is one of the largest and most modern venues in Europe, designed by the Japanese architect Toyo Ito.

Fira Barcelona - Montjuïc

Barcelona International Convention Centre

Located by the sea, the CCIB is an emblem of Barcelona’s avant-garde architecture. It consists of two buildings, the Convention Centre and the Forum Auditorium.

Barcelona, a connected city

Barcelona is located in the northeast of Spain and has great land, sea and air communication. The international airport, Barcelona-El Prat, links the city with Europe's capitals and world destinations. The city has a range of sea links, while road and rail are also good ways of getting to Barcelona. Barcelona also has an efficient and safe public transportation.

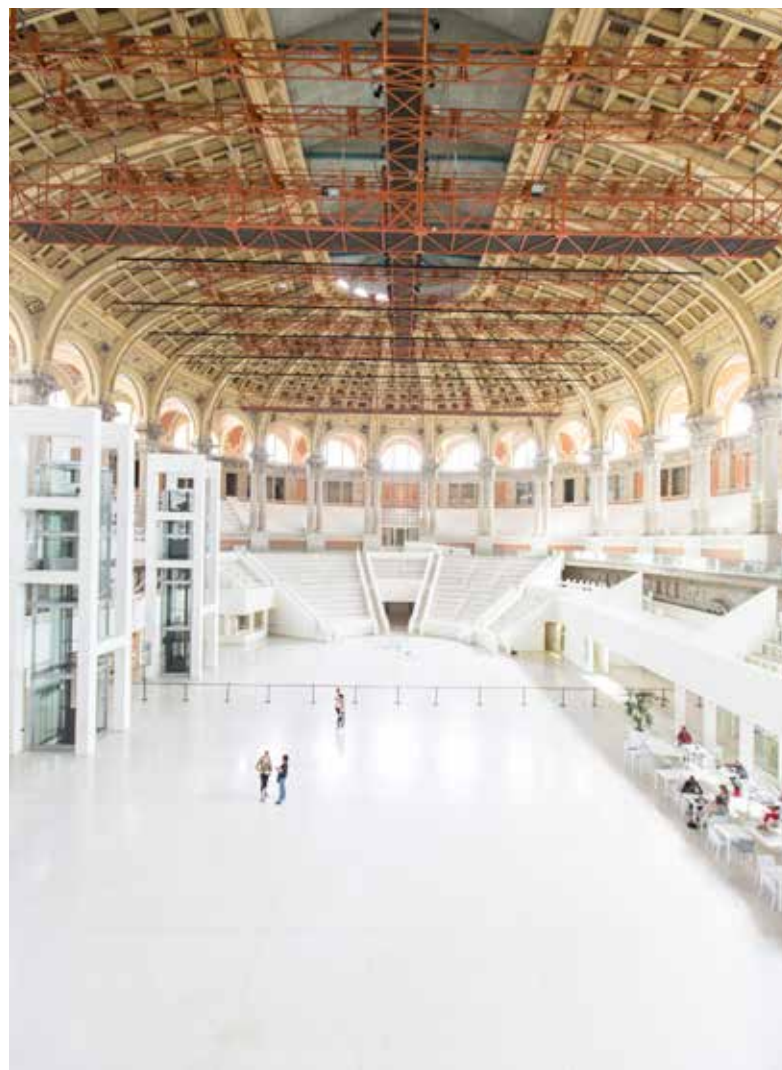
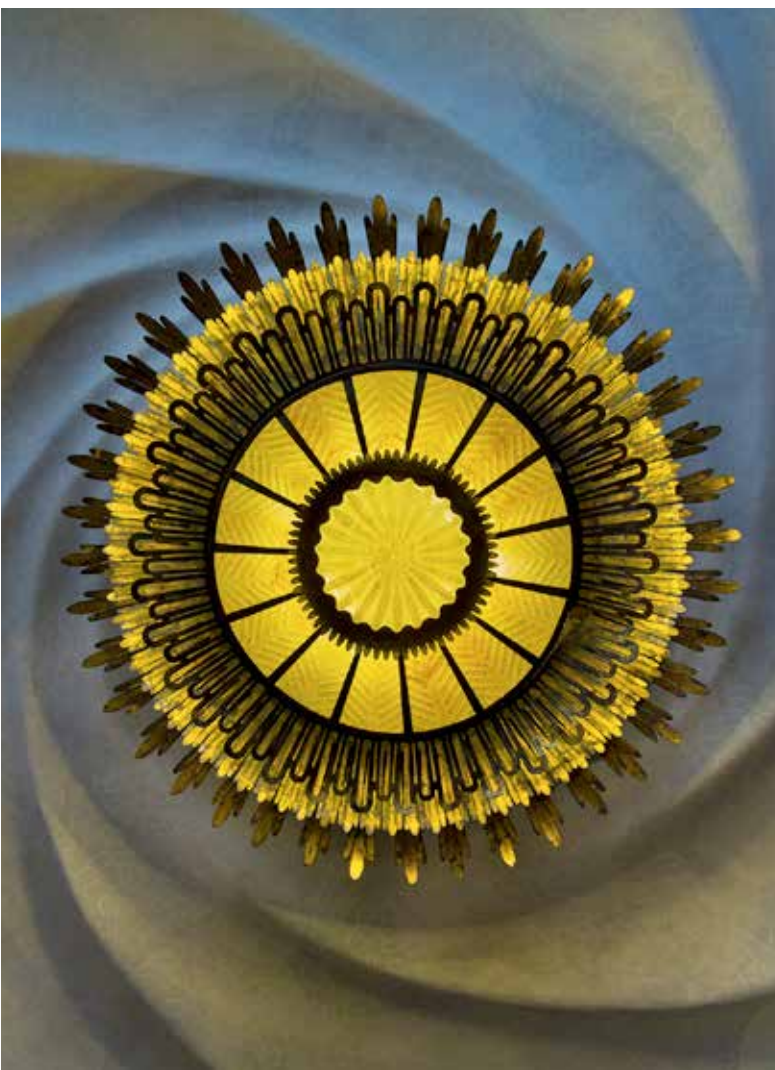

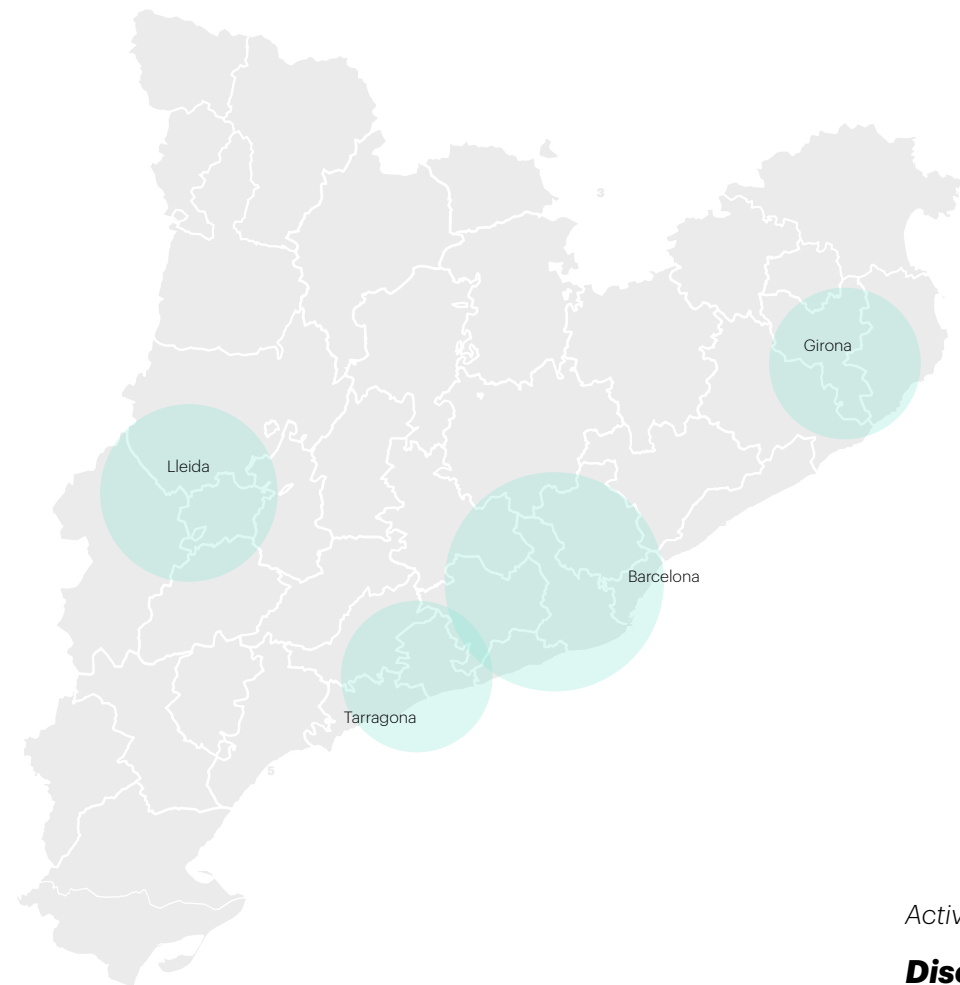
