Barcelona World Sustainable Food Capital 2021 (1/1/2021-31/12/2021)

Here, now, for the planet

Barcelona has set the benchmark for innovation in the field of gastronomy and healthy food with a wealth of Mediterranean dishes made with locally sourced produce. Barcelona's **restaurants** serve traditional dishes featuring market-fresh, seasonal ingredients and well as ground-breaking creations and dishes from around the world. The city has eighteen restaurants with twenty-eight Michelin stars between them, twenty-three municipal fresh food markets across its ten districts and five Designation of Origin wine-producing areas in its neighbouring counties.

Barcelona is firmly committed to sustainability, and this year has been named World Capital of Sustainable Food, as part of the 7th Milan Urban Food Policy Pact Global Forum, which the city will be hosting from 19th to 20th October and will underscore the strategic role of cities in developing sustainable food systems.

In its role as capital, the city will be staging a wide-ranging programme of initiatives and activities related to environmentally friendly, sustainable food and farming.

Highlights include the Sustainable Food Week in October, which will target the local population with the aim of encouraging them to have healthy diets and making healthy ingredients easily accessible, and the **Seasons Menu**, which some restaurants will be serving and will feature dishes based on the principles of sustainability, health and seasonality.

Barcelona World Sustainable Food Capital 2021 will look at, and alert people to some of the most important issues regarding sustainable food that are occurring in cities around the world, including food waste, the responsible consumption of locally sourced produce, the circular economy and waste prevention.
